The AWC's officers and National Show Chairperson held a special late-night work session to determine which of several proposals to host the 2007 AWC National would get their nod. *The Daily Whippet* has the honor of being the first Whippet-related newsletter to break this exciting news to the fancy.

National Show Chairman Cindy Scott relayed the following information to Daily Whippet staffers. "We have chosen to hold the National at a luxury resort outside Honolulu. This is in response to a lot of the feedback we have received over the past few years voicing concerns about the size of the entry, the lack of 'down time' for attendees to relax and

tend to their dogs, the overly-crowded judging schedule, and the increasing difficulty of finding hotels of sufficient size and quality which are willing to host

Two-time BOS Winner Gets His Day in Altered Classes

Judge Cindy Hatcher chose Windsheen Daydream Beeliever FCh, ARX, TRP, DPCX as this year's winner of the Altered competition. Dayvee, as he is known, was bred by Jodi Ellison and David Samuelson of Minnesota and is the son of Ch. Hamrya's Honey Bee, JC, ROM and MBIF Ch. Dashing The Lioness, LCM, ROMX.

Dayvee went Best of Opposite Sex (BOS) in the Altered Class at the 2003 National Specialty in Chicago and at the 2002 National Specialty in Colorado. He has his ASFA field championship, an Award of Racing Excellence (ARX) and a Title of Racing Proficiency (TRP) in Continental Whippet Alliance competition. He also has a CWA Dual Purpose Champion (DPCX) title, one of the first dogs to earn this award. He was #1 in CWA conformation in 2002 and in the top 10 in 2003 and 2004.

Dayvee lives in the Minneapolis, Minnesota, area with owners Bill, Janell

and Danni Johnson. At six years old, Davee is still competitive on the track, Ellison said.

"As a breeder/owner/handler, I strongly believe in the Altered Class, as there are many dogs and bitches who are spayed/neutered as they are much loved pets," Ellison said. "Not every dog needs to be bred, even if they are of breeding quality."

BOS in this year's Altered competition was Elida's Beautiful Noise.

that many dogs for a week."

Treasurer David Samuelson agreed. "We can handle a somewhat smaller entry. The main thing is to give everyone enough time to spend hanging out in the bar. We feel that the Wiki Tiki Hula Resort and Luxury Aloha Village will provide the sort of National Specialty experience our exhibitors seem to expect." He unfolded a brochure to point out several features of interest. "Just look at the size of the pool! And over there's the Tiki Bar, and that little building is where you go to rent your cabana boy. Our exhibitors who are travelling by themselves will appreciate being able to take advantage of that special feature. It's so nice to have someone else to fluff your towels before

you hit the beach."

The sponsor of the winning proposal, Mrs. Barbara "Fifi" Okamura, said she is excited to finally get the opportunity to show off the quality of Hawaiian Whippets to the fanciers from the mainland. "We expect our island Whippets to do quite well at the Honolulu National," she said. "If we just don't put all ten of them in the same class, I think it's not unrealistic to expect them all to get a class win or placement."

Christine Hopperstad, AWC Whippet News Editor, supports the decision. "Mo' entries, mo' problems. Do people have any idea how long it takes me to type up all that stuff for the newsletter?"

Given that many exhibitors might choose to attend without their dogs, the

Board has put together a special competition for those who might normally exhibit, but who will be leaving their dogs at home. Each exhibitor will be allowed to bring a good advertisement of their dog, and these will be judged "American Idol" style in a series of popular votes.

"Exhibitors always complain that the judges only put up the dogs they see in the magazines," Secretary Russ McFadden said. "This way, we just eliminate the element of speculation and allow the judging to be based solely on the impressiveness of the ad."
