Recreational vehicles at Santa Fe Buffalo Thunder are subject to the following terms and conditions:

The RV lot It is located behind and to the East of the hotel.

Price for each space will be \$35 per day. No hotel reservation is required.

There are no water or electric hook-ups. This is dry camping only. No dumping of any kind.

Payment will be required by the first of April 1,2021.

Closing date for reservations is July 1, 2021.

A Genturi or like device to divert generator exhaust is not required but recommended.

You are responsible for clean conditions in and around your space. This includes the grass walking areas around the RV lot.

We do not have designated handicapped spots but will do our best to accommodate you if we have early notice.

Site will be available beginning Sunday October 3rd and must be vacated by 12pm on October 11th.

April in Santa Fe can be rainy, snowy, sunny or all of the above. Plan accordingly. The altitude is 7199 feet.

You will have no hook-ups so be prepared for cold weather with your RV
